WHAT IS LIGHTS ON?

Lights On Program is a Brisbane-based, disability-led on-camera and performance skills program for people with intellectual disability or autism. We provide a supportive, inclusive creative environment where participants build confidence, community connections, and employment-ready skills through the performing arts.

WHO CAN USE NDIS FUNDING FOR LIGHTS ON?

Lights On is available to NDIS participants who are:

- ✓ Plan-managed (your plan manager processes claims), OR
- ✓ Self-managed (you manage your own NDIS budget)

PROGRAM OUTCOMES THAT ALIGN WITH NDIS GOALS

Lights On Program is NOT a registered training provider, RTO, or formal education program. We are a community arts program that delivers outcomes aligned with the NDIS framework:

✓ CAPACITY-BUILDING SKILLS

Confidence, communication, collaboration, creative expression, self-advocacy

✓ COMMUNITY PARTICIPATION

Social connection, group activities, inclusive creative environment, peer relationships

✓ EMPLOYMENT READINESS



Industry exposure, professional skills, portfolio development, work-ready behaviors.

HOW DOES NDIS CLAIMING WORK FOR LIGHTS ON?

STEP 1: CHECK YOUR PLAN

Review your NDIS plan **and** goals **with** your plan manager **or** support coordinator. Identify how Lights On aligns **with** your goals (e.g., social participation, skill development, employment preparation).

STEP 2: CONTACT LIGHTS ON

Email breanna@brockcasting.com.au **to** discuss your interest **in** the program. We'll provide additional program information your supports may need.

STEP 3: ENROLMENT & INVOICING

Once your plan manager **or** support coordinator confirms Lights On **is** suitable, we'll enroll you and provide detailed invoices showing:

- Session dates **and** hours
- NDIS line item codes
- Service description aligned **with** your NDIS goals

STEP 4: YOUR PLAN MANAGER PROCESSES PAYMENT

Your plan manager submits claims **to** NDIS **on** your behalf **using** the invoices we provide. (**If** you're self-managed, you submit claims directly.)



COMMON QUESTIONS

"WILL MY PLAN MANAGER APPROVE THIS?"

Approval depends **on** your individual NDIS goals **and** plan. We recommend discussing Lights **On with** your plan manager **or** support coordinator before enrolling. We're happy to provide documentation to help them assess suitability.

"WHAT IF MY LAC SAYS THIS LOOKS LIKE EDUCATION OR TRAINING?"

Lights **On is NOT** school education, higher education, **or** vocational training. We are a community arts program focused **on** social participation **and** skill development—**not** qualifications **or** certifications. We use Capacity Building (Social & Community Participation) line items, **not** education budgets.

"CAN I USE MY CORE OR CAPACITY BUILDING BUDGET?"

Most participants use Capacity Building: Social, Community & Civic Participation budget. Some also use Core: Social **and** Community Participation budget depending **on** plan **structure**. Your plan manager can advise which applies **to** you.



"WHAT DOCUMENTATION WILL YOU PROVIDE?"

We provide:

- Detailed invoices **with** NDIS line item codes
- Program information outlining how Lights **On** supports your NDIS goals
- Direct communication **with** your plan manager **or** support coordinator **as** needed
